F868 Quality Assessment and Assurance

• "§483.80(c) Infection Preventionist participation on quality assessment and assurance committee. The individual designated as the IP, or at least one of the individuals if there is more than one IP, must be a member of the facility's quality assessment and assurance committee and report to the committee on the IPCP on a regular

• "Regular basis": for the purpose of the infection preventionist reporting requirement, reporting should occur at the same frequency as the QAA committee meetings."
